

Ingersoll Stadium Use Rules

“A Community Resource”

1. Community use is limited to individuals for the purpose of personal exercise and recreation
2. The facility is locked overnight between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Individual members of the community, with a key card, may access the facility between 5 a.m. and 10 p.m. with the exceptions noted below.
 - a. For the safety of students the facility is closed to public access, even with a key-card, when an Olympia School District (OSD) school is conducting classes or athletics practices and games. If using the track prior to a class, practice or game, please respect teachers and coaches when they ask you to leave the premises.
 - b. In order to preserve the turf field, key-card holders' use is limited to the track; please do not use the turf field. Use of the turf field is limited to scheduled and approved (community user groups*), school district classes, school activities, school/district athletic practices and games.
 - c. Community members are welcome to attend OSD school games (some games involve a charge); even if you have a key-card the track is unavailable during these games.
 - d. Community members are welcome to watch the practices and game of approved (community user groups*). If using the track during approved community group practices/games please use lanes 7 and 8 and do so in a manner not distracting to the user group and spectators.

3. Commercial use of the facility is prohibited, including use by personal trainers or others charging a fee for services rendered.
4. Food, gum, seeds, shells, sports drinks or glass containers are allowed on the track or field surfaces – a \$200 cleaning fee will be charged for violations.
5. Parking or any use of a vehicle (including bicycles, skateboards, scooters, skates, etc) is prohibited inside the fenced area of the facility.
6. The grandstands are for watching games. Personal exercise is limited to walking stairs and is done at the individual's own risk. Use caution when walking on grandstand steps; these can become slick with rain and moisture. The seating areas may not be used for any form of exercise.
7. Approved service animals are the only animals allowed inside the fenced area.
8. The District has installed security cameras at access gates and in locations to view the field and track. We will review the tapes as necessary if there is facility misuse and/or damage.
9. Misconduct, misuse, possession or use of intoxicating beverages and/or controlled substances, the carrying of fireworks, weapons or other violations of established regulations noted in OSD Procedures 4260P - C or D, and/or the community access agreement, will be sufficient cause for denial and/or termination of access.
